

Senior School Uniform GUIDELINES


Boys may not wear earrings.

Ties should always be worn in school but may be removed when playing on the field. They must be tied neatly, tight to the collar. They must be school ties and your top button should be done up.

Blazers should be worn at all times on the corridor and at all formal occasions including assembly. You can ask to take it off during lessons. You can take it off on the fields.

Shirts must be tucked in.

Socks up to Year 11 must be dark grey. Trainer socks are not permitted except for PE.



Hair should be presentable and tidy.

Hair must be of a natural colour. "Two-tone" effects are not permitted.

Distracting hairstyles are not allowed - no tram lines, Mohican styles, excessive gel, etc.

Boys should be clean shaven or neatly groomed (for cultural sensitivity).

Black shoes of a sturdy and sensible nature should be worn – trainers are not acceptable. Shoes should have a leather finish.

Make up should be kept to an 'invisible' or natural look.

Ties should always be worn in school but may be removed when playing on the field. They must be tied neatly, tight to the collar. They must be school ties and your top button should be done up.

Blazers should be worn at all times on the corridor and at all formal occasions including assembly. You can ask to take it off during lessons. You can take it off on the fields.

Skirts must be of modest length, resting on the knee or reaching below it. Charcoal trousers are permitted

Socks up to Year 11 must be dark grey. Trainer socks are not permitted except for PE. Dark grey tights are permitted as an alternative to dark grey socks.



Hair must brushed and presentable. It needs to be fully up and completely off the face.

Hair must be of a natural colour. "Two-tone" effects are not permitted.

Hair ties/bands/clips should be non-distracting and in the College colours.

There should be no unnecessary adornments like flowers, bows or extensions.

Hair must be of a natural colour. Distracting styles and "two-tone" effects are not permitted.

No jewellery is permitted apart from one pair of small plain stud earrings.

Nail varnish is not permitted

Black shoes should be formal – trainers or sneakers are not acceptable.

Shoes should have a leather finish..
